To facilitate your browsing through the website, INCATUK (hereinafter, “INCATUK”) with registered company address at Merlin Place, Milton Road – Cambridge CB4 0DP - UK, informs you that, its website www.incatuk.com (the “Website”), in order to facilitate browsing, uses cookies or other files having a similar functionality (hereinafter, the “Cookies”).

The purpose of the present policy is to inform you (hereinafter, the “User”) about the cookies used by this Website. By using our services, you accept the use we make of our cookies. In all events, we inform you that the provider is responsible for the Cookies and for the processing of the data obtained through their own and third party Cookies deciding on their finality, content and processing use of the information collected. At any time, you may withdraw your consent to use of this technology by means of your browser’s functions, by deactivating the Cookies or blocking the possibility of their being downloaded onto your device.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are files that are stored in the User’s device when they visit a web page. Cookies allow us to facilitate browsing when accessing the Website, by improving its quality and helping us to resolve potential functioning errors.

What do Cookies do?

Our Cookies do not personally identify the User, and collect neutral data. They are used by websites to improve the User’s browsing experience, facilitating secure data travel through the internet and helping us to understand which is the most useful website information or to know which offers may be of interest for each User.

Which specific Cookies does this website use?

This website uses technical and analytical Cookies.

Next, we provide information concerning the Cookies used by this Website.

Analysis Cookies:

These allow for monitoring and analysis of the behaviour of users of the website to which these cookies are associated. The whole of the information collected by all visitors to the Website is collected, meaning that it is anonymous. Said information is used with the

objective of measuring the activity of the website, application or platform, and to prepare user navigation profiles, to help to introduce improvements based on analysis of the data on how users use the service.

INCATUK cannot control nor does it assume responsibility for the content and veracity of the terms and conditions of the Google Analytics privacy policies. It is Google Inc, that determines the final purpose of the processing and use of the information captured from them, and also the functioning and duration of the Cookies, and according to the information provided by both, the user can avoid capture of said information, by rejecting the installation of cookies through configuring their browser for their part.

Google Analytics	_utma	This is a persistent cookie which expires after 20 years. It monitors the number of times that the user has opened a Website, and when they first and last visited the Website.
	_utmb	Used to know the duration of the visit to the Website.

	_utmz	Monitors the web pages previously visited by the user, the search engine used by the user, where the user has clicked on, and geographical location from which the search was made. The maximum duration it can have is six months.
	_utmt	Used to limit the percentage of requests. You can visit the Google website to consult the description of the cookies used by the Google Analytics system and their expiry period, for more information click here .
Google	NID	This is a unique identifier used by Google applications for the purpose of storing information regarding the user's preferences.

Technical Cookies:

They allow the User to browse the Website and use the different options or services available, and are necessary to be able to access all parts of the Website without any problem. For example, they are used to control traffic and data communication, identify the session, access restricted areas, remember the elements that make up an order, carry out an order purchase process, make a request for registration or participation in an

event, use security elements during navigation, store content for the broadcasting of videos or sound or content sharing through social media.

The Website can use Cookies that remember the browsing preferences during your visit. Among these, it can recognise the type of device used for navigation by the User, with a view to customising the User's interface.
